This quality improvement project is at the level of seeking ethics approval
- **SickKids Caribbean Initiative (SCI)** - In 2013, the SickKids Center for Global Child Health at the Hospital for Sick Children (SickKids), Toronto, Canada launched a 5-year, not-for-profit partnership to improve health related quality of life and increase survival for children with cancer and blood disorders by sharing her clinical expertise with six English-speaking (low and middle income) Caribbean countries: The Bahamas, Barbados, Jamaica, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines and Trinidad and Tobago. The success of the initiative is grounded on the strong collaboration with local healthcare workers, the Ministries of Health, hospital administrations, the Faculty of Medical Sciences at the University of the West Indies, and the SickKids Centre for Global Child Health.

This project raised 8MM as well as other tangible donations with goals to:

1. Build capacity among paediatric healthcare professionals and allied healthcare professionals through training and education in the areas of: nursing, pharmacy, pathology, laboratory, medicine and social work.
2. Strengthen diagnostic capabilities through strategic laboratory enhancements.
3. Establish best practices and health outcome through the development of local oncology registries.
4. Improve clinical management and treatment of paediatric patients with cancer and blood disorders.
5. Provide overall project management for this initiative that allows for the facilitation and implementation of all project deliverables.
